Davis Golf Course Protocols

(as of April 2020 until further notice)

<u>Place a sign at each entrance of the check in window and snack bar as well as bathrooms to inform all employees and golfers should:</u>

- Avoid entering the facility if they feel sick or have a cough or fever.
- Maintain a minimum 6 foot distance from anyone who is not a household member.
- Sneeze and cough into a cloth or tissue or if not available - into an elbow.
- Not shake hands or engage in unnecessary physical contact; and,
- Wear a face covering in compliance with this plan.
- Face masks should be worn around the buildings, in the snack bar, restrooms, and on the practice greens.
- Tournaments or gatherings are not allowed.

Measures to protect employee health:

- All employees have been told to not come to work if sick.
- Everyone who can carry out their work duties from home has been directed to do so.
- Symptom checks are being conducted before employees enter the work space.
- Maintain social distancing amongst employees and patrons.

- Bathrooms and other common areas are disinfected at least every hour.
- Disinfectant and related supplies are available to all employees at the back door of the snack bar.
- Hand sanitizer is available for all employees outside the pro shop door and inside the snack bar.
- Employees must wear face coverings that cover the face and mouth.
- Employees must wash their hands frequently or use hand sanitizer and may wear rubber gloves.
- Copies of this plan have been distributed to all employees.

Measures to protect golfer's health off the course:

- Snack bar will remain open only for grab and go service.
- Seating is removed from dining areas both inside and outside.
- Servers will wear face coverings and wash their hands and change gloves frequently.
- Require golfers to leave the property immediately after playing in order to eliminate congestion.
- Customers will maintain at least a 6 foot distance while in line at pro shop window and snack bar.
- Bathroom and snack bar doors will remain propped open.
- Limit of 2 people per bathroom at a time.
- Require tee times to be made in advance on the phone or online to eliminate walk up golfers.
- Offer payment and check-in in advance in a manner that does not include exchanging currency at the pro shop window.

- The pro shop will remain locked during business hours.
- Fenced or roped off common gathering areas.

Measures to protect golfer's health in golf practice areas:

- Remove all flag sticks from practice areas.
- Cups have been raised I inch from the hole so ball cannot be holed.
- Every other stall is closed at the driving range to encourage the social distancing during golfer practice.
- Golfers may only use their own golf balls while using the putting green.
- Rubber tees have been removed from the mats at the driving range for golfer's safety.

Measures to protect golfer's health on the course.

- Tee times have been spread out from 8 minute intervals to 12 minute intervals.
- No club rentals
- Pull carts will be cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- Score cards will be available on the steering wheel of each drive cart for use.
- Sharing drive carts with members from different households is prohibited.
- Players may remove their face masks once on the golf course.
- Golfers should not touch or remove the flag sticks.
- Rakes are removed from bunkers.
- The cup has foam in it, the ball will not fall in.

- Water dispensers have been removed from the course.
- Ball washers are disabled on the course.
- Encouraging "gimmies" to reduce crowding near the hole.
- Trash cans will remain touchless.
- Course restrooms will remain open and will be sanitized frequently.
- Junior golfers must be accompanied by an adult.

Measures to increase sanitation:

- Disinfecting wipes and cleaning bottles are available to sanitize carts and touching surfaces.
- Employees will disinfect carts (including rental pull carts) after each use.
- Disinfecting high contact surfaces frequently.
- Disinfecting payment portals regularly.
